# Tribute Wall



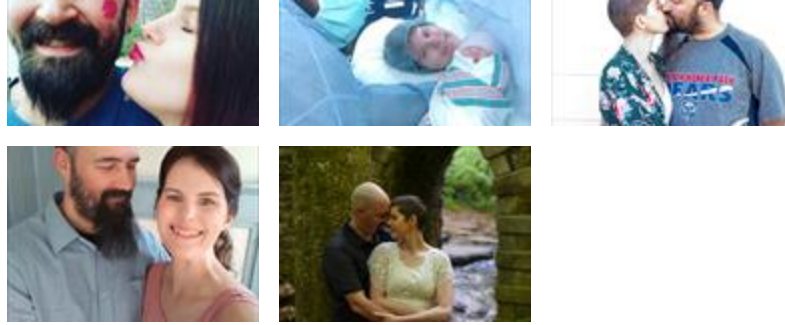
“ It's taken me some time to gather the courage to post on here. Every time I see obituary, and see my handsome husbands picture, I break down. How can it be my husband I am having to write this about? Why was he taken away from me? How do I form words into sentences to really tell people how much he meant to me? To really capture just how amazing he was? I can't. There simply isn't enough words to accurately describe him, or how I am feeling. I will try my best though.

*My husband was my best friend. Has been since the moment we met way back in 8th grade. Every time I saw him, I would get those butterflies in my stomach. Every time he hugged me, I just knew we were supposed to be together. There was never a moment where he wasn't on my mind, and there won't ever be a moment he isn't. He was my rock. My strength. My safety.*

*I was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer back in September, and while going through chemo, he was there to lift me up when I was so sick, I could barely lift my head. He bathed me, fed me, kept me laughing, and just made sure I knew that he would not leave my side. He assured me, even when I lost all my hair, that he still thought I was gorgeous. Made me feel like I was the most beautiful thing on the planet. Was my shoulder when I would break down. Picked me up and carried me when I felt I couldn't go another step. He stepped for me.*

*He was the best husband and friend a person could ask for. I feel so lucky that I found that once in a lifetime love that I found with him. That compatible on every level super rare kind of love! We didn't have near enough time together. However, I wouldn't trade the last 7 and a half years together, 5 married, for anything. He was my person. My soulmate. There will never be a day that goes by that I won't think of his warmth. His smile. The way his arms felt wrapped around me. His smell. His sarcasm. I am going to miss him so so very much.*

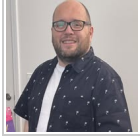
